

# Spooner Municipal Utility

## ELECTRIC RATE SCHEDULE

This information is provided to users of electric power in accordance with Public Service Commission regulation. Information is published periodically so that users will be aware of the rates for the various types of service.

### RESIDENTIAL RATES (Rq-1)

Fixed Charge .....	\$12.00 per month
Energy Charge .....	\$0.1180 cents per kWh, plus PCAC

### RESIDENTIAL TIME-OF-USE SERVICE RATES (OPTIONAL) (Rq-2)

Fixed Charge .....	\$12.00 per month
Energy Charge: On-Peak .....	\$0.1855 cents per kWh, plus PCAC
Off-Peak .....	\$0.0824 cents per kWh, plus PCAC

ON PEAK: 9:00 am – 9:00 pm, Monday through Friday, excluding holidays

This rate is optional to all Rg-1 Residential Service customers. Customers that wish to be served on this rate schedule must apply to the utility for service. Once an optional customer begins service on this rate schedule, the customer shall remain on the rate for a minimum of one year. Any customer choosing to be served on this rate schedule waives all rights to billing adjustments arising from a claim that the bill for service would be less on another rate schedule than under this rate schedule.

### GENERAL SERVICE RATES (Gs-1)

#### 1 PHASE

Fixed Charge .....	\$17.00 per month
Energy Charge .....	\$0.1191 cents per kWh, plus PCAC

### GENERAL SERVICE RATES (Gs-1)

#### 3 PHASE

Fixed Charge .....	\$28.00 per month
Energy Charge .....	\$0.1191 cents per kWh, plus PCAC

### SMALL POWER (Cp-1)

This rate will be applied to customers for all types of service if their monthly maximum measured demand is in excess of 75 kilowatts (kW) per month for three or more months in a consecutive 12-month period, but not greater than 200 kW per month for three or more months in a consecutive 12-month period.

Customer Charge .....	\$65.00 per month
Distribution Demand Charge .....	\$2.00
Demand Power .....	\$8.50 per kW of billed customer demand
Energy Charge .....	\$0.0765 cents per kWh, plus PCAC

**LARGE POWER TIME-OF-DAY SERVICE (Cp-2)**

This rate will be applied to customers for all types of service if their monthly maximum measured demand is in excess of 200 kilowatts (kW) per month for three or more months in a consecutive 12-month period. Customers billed on this rate shall continue to be billed on this rate until their monthly maximum measured demand is less than 200 kW per month for 12 consecutive months.

Customer Charge .....	\$160.00 per month
Demand Charge .....	\$10.00 per kW of billed on-peak demand
Distribution Demand Charge .....	\$2.25 per kW of billed customer demand
Energy Charge: On-Peak .....	\$0.0864 cents per kWh, plus PCAC
Off-Peak .....	\$0.0571 cents per kWh, plus PCAC

**SECURITY LIGHTING RATES**

100 watt HPS .....	\$7.00 per lamp per month
150 watt HPS .....	\$8.00 per lamp per month
54 watt LED .....	\$8.00 per lamp per month
48 watt LED .....	\$7.50 per lamp per month
40 watt LED .....	\$7.00 per lamp per month
Energy charge .....	\$0.0849 cents per kWh, plus PCAC

**OTHER CHARGES**

Regular business hours reconnection .....	\$40.00
After hours reconnection.....	\$80.00
Seasonal Customer reconnection .....	\$40.00
<i>A seasonal customer shall also be charged for all minimum bills that would have been incurred had the customer not temporarily disconnected service</i>	
NSF (Non Sufficient Funds) .....	\$8.00
New or Successor Customer.....	\$10.00 Initiation Charge – to cover costs involved in meter reading and initiation of customer record

**PROMPT PAYMENT OF BILLS**

A charge of 1.0% per month shall be applied to the total unpaid balance, including any unpaid payment charges. This charge will be added to bills not paid within 20 days from the date of issuance.

It is recommended to set your water heater thermostat at no higher than 125°F in order to prevent severe burns and unnecessary energy.
